The ATAE team is proud of its collaboration with “Die Bodenkultur” Journal and we are pleased that through this, our Symposium delegates have the opportunity to have their work published in this scientific journal.

Authors of selected papers from ATAE Symposium or CASEE session “Agricultural Engineering” will be invited to submit publication in peer reviewed special issue of “Die Bodenkultur” journal. Five papers will be rigorously peer-reviewed and after acceptance be tracked through the publication progress and published in a special issue.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The selection for the Peer Review Process and consequent publication in the special journal issue is apart from and in addition to the publication in the Symposium Proceedings of the ATAE resp. CASEE. The authors who have been invited to submit to the journal “Die Bodenkultur” need to prepare 2 different papers – one for the proceedings and one for the Journal (extended and improved version). Selected papers will go through the rigorous peer-review process with the same standard as for regular submissions and they **MUST** contain about 50% new content compared to the Symposium papers. Each manuscript will be reviewed according to the Journal policy.

The review process for this special issue will be overseen by Martin H. Gerzabek and Andreas Gronauer, University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences (BOKU), Vienna, Austria. Assistance during the whole submission and revision process will be provide by the journals Managing Editor Reinhard Neugschwandtner (reinhard.neugschwandtner@boku.ac.at).

The procedure for the first special issue “Agricultural Engineering” published in the journal “Die Bodenkultur” is scheduled as follows:

10 March 2019 Notification of acceptance and invitation for submission of a research paper to “Die Bodenkultur”

31 May 2019 Deadline for submission of the full manuscript to “Die Bodenkultur”

31 July 2019 Reviewed manuscripts will be (latest) returned to the authors for the revision

31 August 2019 Deadline for the submission of the revised manuscripts (according to the reviewers’ comments)

November 2019 Procedure completed; accepted papers ready for printing
